NOTIFICATION

RECRUITMENT AND PROMOTION RULES FOR THE POSTS OF ASSISTANT DIRECTOR/DISTRICT AYURVEDIC OFFICER/MEDICAL SUPERINTENDENT (GAZETTED) CLASS-I, IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INDIAN SYSTEM OF MEDICINE AND HOMOEOPATHY, HIMACHAL PRADESH.

1. Name of the post : Assistant Director/District Ayurvedic Officer/Medical Superintendent.
2. Number of posts : Assistant Director - 02  
District Ayurvedic Officer - 12

3. Classification : Class-I (Gazetted) Ministerial Services

9. Period of probation if any : Two years subject to such further extension for a period not exceeding one year as may be ordered by the competent authority in special circumstances and reasons to be recorded in writing.

10. Method of recruitment, : 100% by promotion whether by direct recruitment or by promotion, deputation, transfer and percentage of vacancies to be filled in by various methods.

11. In case of recruitment by promotion, deputation, transfer, grade from which promotion/transfer/deputation is to be made : By promotion from amongst the Sub Divisional Ayurvedic Medical Officers who possess atleast three years regular service or regular combined with continuous adhoc (Rendered upto 31-03-1998) service, if any, in the grade failing which by promotion from amongst the Sub Divisional Ayurvedic Medical Officers who possess fifteen years regular service or regular combined with continuous adhoc (rendered upto 31-03-1993) service as Sub Divisional Ayurvedic Medical Officer and Ayurvedic Medical Officer combined.

(1) In all cases of promotion, the continuous adhoc service rendered in the feeder post upto 31-03-1998, if any, prior to regular appointment to the post shall be taken into account towards the length of service as prescribed in these Rules for promotion subject to the condition that the adhoc appointment/promotion in the feeder category had been made after following proper acceptable process of selection in accordance with the provisions of R&P Rules, provided that in all cases where a junior person becomes eligible for consideration by virtue of his total length of service (including the service rendered on adhoc basis upto 31-03-1998) in the feeder post in view of the provisions referred to above, all persons senior to him in the respective category/post/cadre shall be deemed to be eligible for consideration and placed above the junior person in the field of consideration :

Provided that all incumbents to be considered for promotion shall possess the minimum qualifying service of at least three years or that prescribed in the R&P Rules for the post, whichever is less :

Provided further that where a person becomes ineligible to be considered for promotion on account of the requirements of the preceding proviso, the person(s) junior to him shall also be deemed to be ineligible for consideration for such promotion.

Explanation:- The last proviso shall not render the junior incumbents ineligible for consideration for promotion if the senior ineligible persons happened to be ex-servicemen recruited under the provisions of Rule-3 of Demobilised Armed Forces Personnel (Reservation of Vacancies in Himachal State Non-Technical Services) Rules, 1972 and having been given the benefit of seniority thereunder or recruited under the provisions of Rule-3 of Ex-servicemen (Reservation of Vacancies in the Himachal Pradesh Technical Services) Rules, 1985 and having been given the benefit of seniority thereunder.

(2) Similarly, in all cases of confirmation, adhoc service rendered on the feeder post upto 31-03-1998, if any, prior to the regular appointment against such post shall be taken into account towards the length of service, if the adhoc appointment/promotion had been made after proper selection and in accordance with the provision of the R&P Rules:

Provided that inter-se-seniority as a result of confirmation after taking into account adhoc service rendered upto 31-03-1998 as referred to above shall remain unchanged.

- 12. If a Departmental Promotion Committee exists, what is its composition. : As may be constituted by the Government from time to time.
- 13. Circumstances under which the H.P.P.S.C. is to be consulted in making recruitment : As required under the law.
- 14. Essential requirement for a direct recruitment. : Not applicable.
- 15. Selection for appointment to post by direct recruitment. : Not applicable.

16. Reservation : The appointment to the service shall be subject to orders regarding reservation in the service for Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes/Backward Classes/ other categories of persons issued by the Himachal Pradesh Government from time to time.
17. Departmental Examination : Every member of the service shall pass a Departmental Examination as prescribed in the H.P. Departmental Examination Rules, 1997 as amended from time to time.
18. Power to relax : Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the H.P.P.S.C. relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons or posts.

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
